2025 Pricing

\$500: Base membership fee for all Institutional Members

Price increases based on the number of physical locations and states serviced via teletherapy at the following rates, with a max yearly payment of \$2,500 regardless of locations/states:

- Physical location:
 - 1st included in the base fee of \$500
 - 2nd through 6th locations = additional \$100 each
 - 7th through 10th locations = additional \$75 each
 - 11th+ location = additional \$50 each
- o Teletherapy states: \$25 each (fee for the state of the physical location(s) waived)

Example: An Institutional Member with three physical clinics in California, Arizona, and New Mexico with therapists licensed to treat via teletherapy in WA, OR, ID, CA, NV UT AZ, and NM would pay \$500 (base) + \$200 (additional 2 locations) + \$125 (5 additional states) = \$825

Pricing applies to all clinic types: Specialty Outpatient Clinics, Intensive Treatment Programs, Residential Programs, Partial Hospitalization, and/or Research Clinics
